



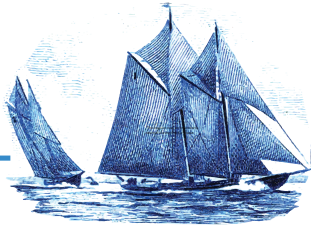

The Bluenose was the fastest schooner in the world.

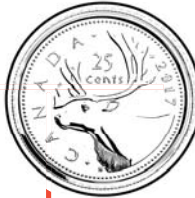


Dime (10¢) – Silver

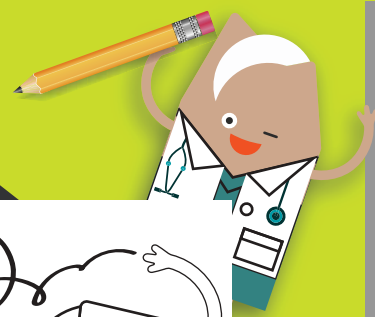

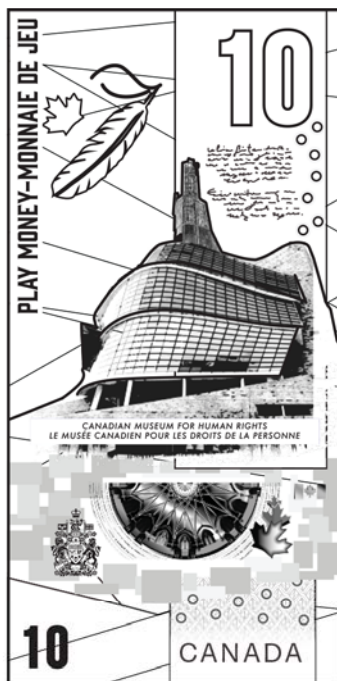
